#### A Message from MCA Executive Director, Jaye Baillie, APR



MCA's Board adopted a very ambitious strategic plan that has guided our efforts in 2021 and 2022. While it continues to drive our direction through 2023, work will begin in mid-year to update the plan for the next three years. Output from the 2022 Plan's Direction included:

- Designated Local Arts Agency status by the City of Ocala
- Increased programming at The Brick to include artists' workshops, live performances, and lunch and learns
- Awarded grants from the Florida Department of Cultural Affairs (\$25,000)
- Awarded \$25,000 in Cultural Grants bringing the total awarded since MCA's founding in 2001 to \$435,000
- Increased diversity on MCA's Board of Directors, staff and representation by artists participating in exhibits
- Staged 3 arts professionals "Happy Hours"
- Staged the 15th Annual Applaud the Arts and awarded arts awards for Service (Joanne Ohlman), Vision (Jessica McCune), Arts Education (Brittany Schofield), and Lifetime Achievement (Laurie Reeder).
- · Increased membership, sponsorships, art, and gift shop sales
- Refurbished The Shop to showcase artists' new creative merchandise each quarter
- Implemented a business pARTner program
- Partnered with Bookhouse Publishing to create Ocala: The Art of Community Coffee Table book
- · Hosted monthly gatherings for art leaders allowing time to build relationships and look for opportunities to collaborate and together, created ARTober Fest to spotlight and market our community's robust arts and cultural scene
- Created an online calendar for arts and cultural events
- Established the Arts in Business program creating art galleries in three businesses and commissioning artists to create 4 new horses for the Horse Fever herd
- Participated in the Americans for the Arts Economic and Prosperity VI study that will quantify the economic impact of Ocala/Marion County's creative industry

This list of highlights is a mere snapshot of what's been accomplished by our engaged Board of Directors and the dedicated MCA team, with support from our members, artists, sponsors, and arts patrons. Together we are making great strides to make Ocala/Marion County one of the best communities for the ARTS.
